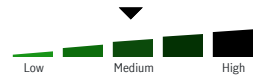

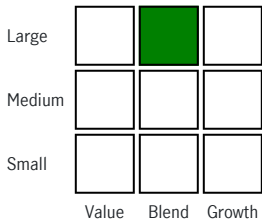

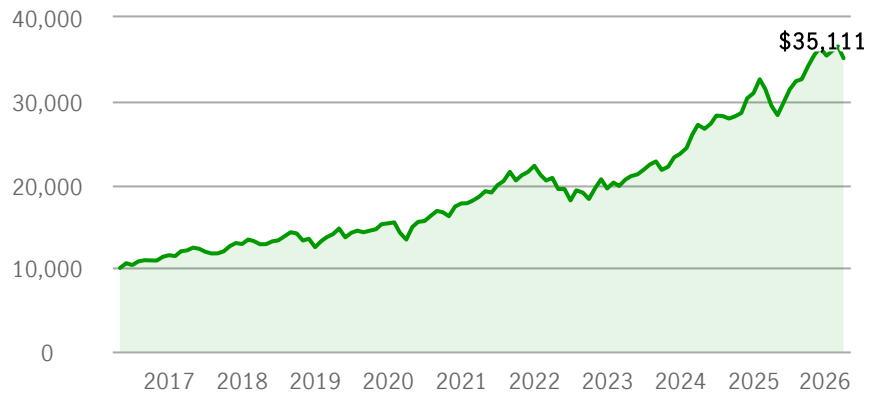

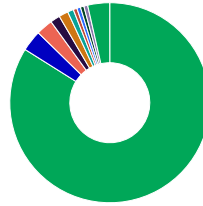

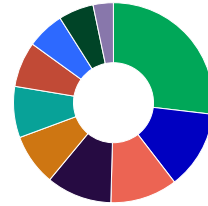

### Geographic Allocation (%)



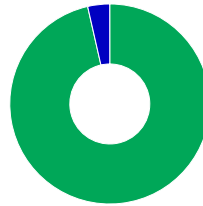
