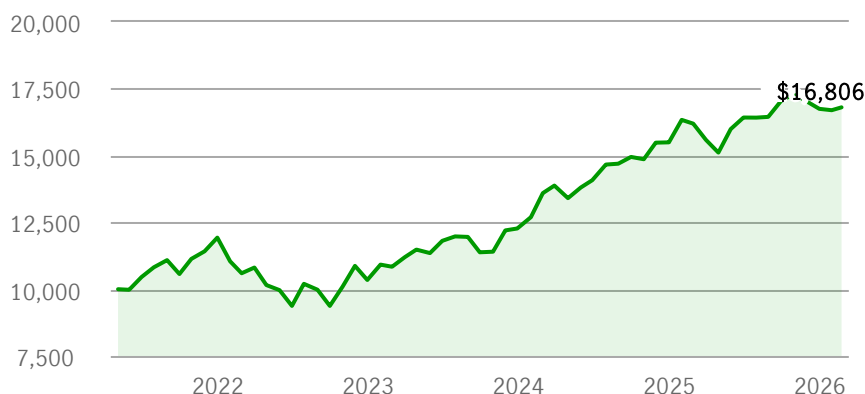

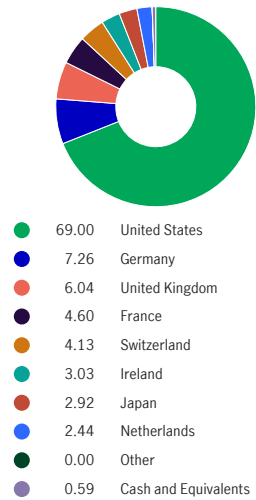

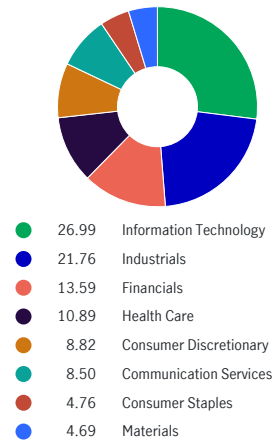

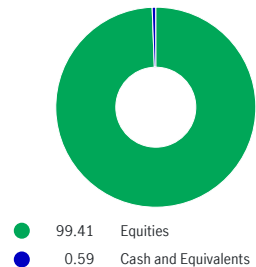
Geographic Allocation (%)
