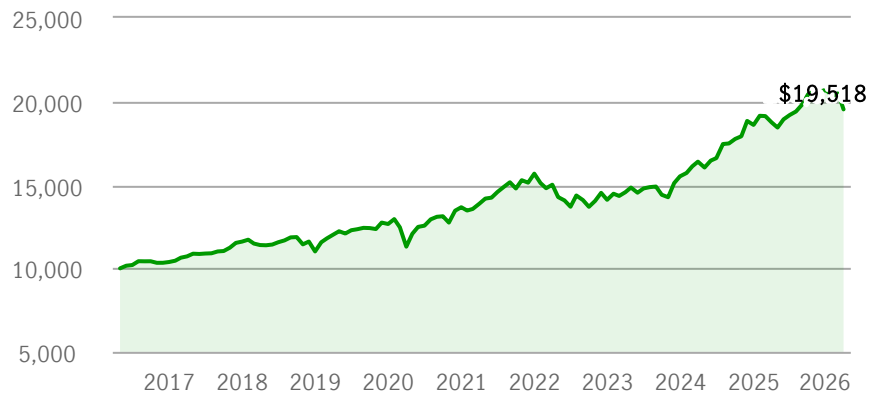

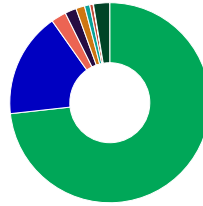

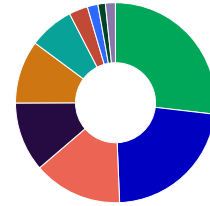

Geographic Allocation (%)



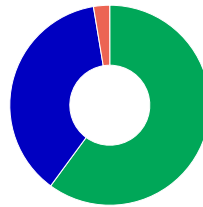

Sector Allocation (Equities) (%)



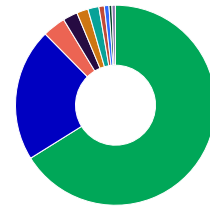
