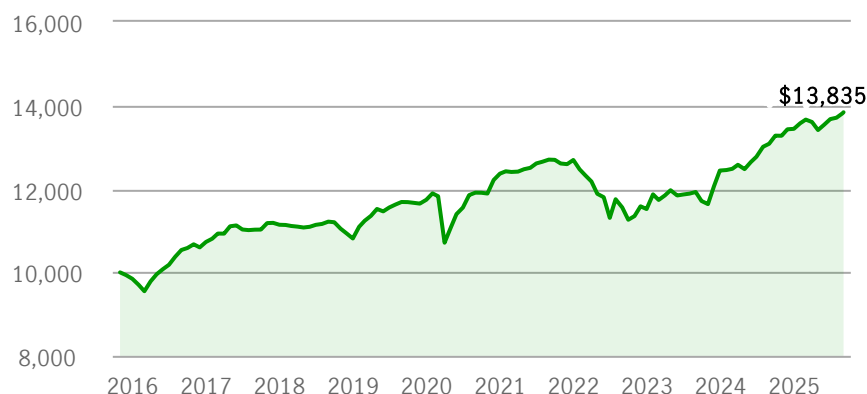

Why invest?

- Seeks to provide a steady flow of high income and long-term capital appreciation through investments in North American investment grade corporate and high yield bonds.
- The investment grade corporate bond component of the Fund is managed based on a combination of top-down macroeconomic research and bottom-up fundamental credit analysis. The high yield component will be managed using fundamental credit analysis (bottom-up) to select those securities and sectors believed to be offering the best relative value. Stable, credit-worthy issuers will be emphasized in portfolio construction.
- Seeks to provide an enhanced yield profile in a time of low interest rates, and strives to insulate investors in times of rising interest rates.

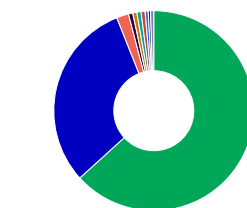

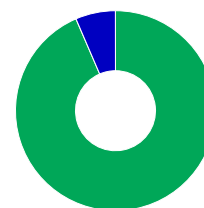

Geographic Allocation (%)



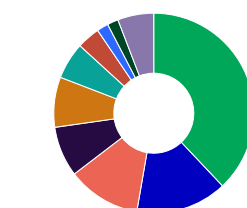

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The Morningstar Rating, commonly referred to as the Star Rating, relates how a fund has performed on a risk-adjusted basis against its Morningstar category peers and is subject to change every month. Calculations are based on the funds in each Morningstar category to better measure fund manager skill. The Star Ratings as of July 31, 2025 for the Funds shown and the number of funds within their categories for each period are:
Manulife Corporate Bond Fund within the Canada Fund High Yield Fixed Income category: 1 year period, n/a stars & 273 funds, 3 year period, 3 stars & 263 funds, 5 year period, 4 stars & 231 funds, 10 year period, 3 stars & 118 funds. Funds are ranked by their Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return scores with the top 10% of funds in a category receiving 5 stars, the top 22.5% receiving 4 stars; a fund in the middle 35% receiving 3 stars; a fund in the next 22.5% receiving 2 stars and a fund in the bottom 10% receiving 1 star. The Overall Star Rating for a fund is a weighted combination of its 3, 5 and 10 year ratings. Overall ratings are adjusted where a fund has less than 5 or 10 years of history.
