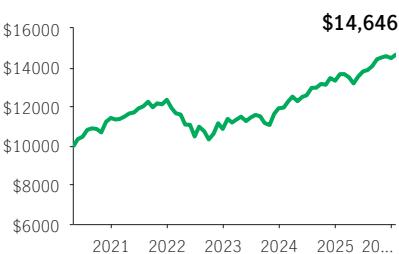

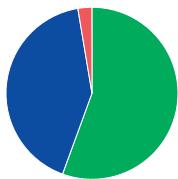

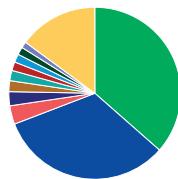

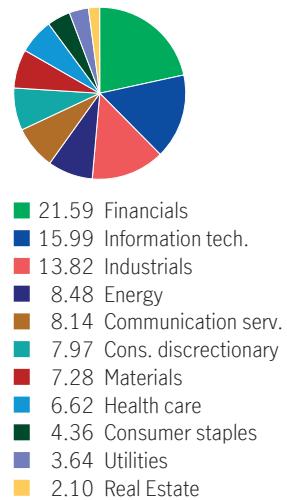
### ASSET ALLOCATION %
