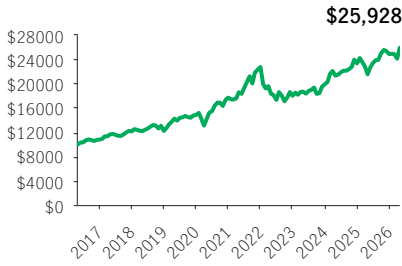

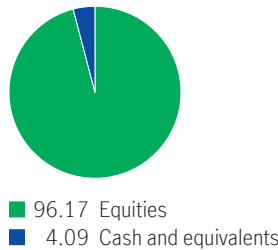

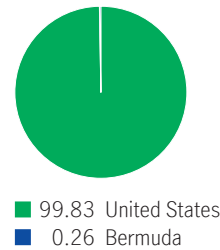

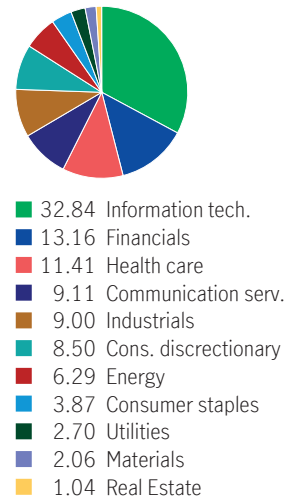
ASSET ALLOCATION %
